E. Wilbur Walls and Elsie Jackson, were united in marriage in a Methodist Parsonage on April 1, 1908, at Pawnee, Oklahoma. Six Children were born of the Union; two died in infancy; Roy lived until he was seventeen, and three of us have lived to adulthood. There are ten Grand Children and two Great Grand Children. Father, Mother, Mable, Paul and Wesley now live in Seattle.

Shortly after their marriage, Father and Mother were converted under the Ministry of Pearl Wells Carlton, and they joined the Free Methodist Church in 1912. Father entered the Ministry in 1919, and served six Pastorates in Oklahoma, two in Nebraska, three in Iowa, and for eight years was the Superintendent of the Iowa Conference. He was twice elected to the General Board of the Church, and served on the Executive and Evangelistic Commissions. He also served as a General Conference Evangelist. They retired in 1957 and now reside at $2008\frac{1}{2}$ Nob Hill Avenue, Seattle, Washington.
